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- Ask students: Where do you think technology could make our program better? Which digital learning activities do you enjoy? What are curious to learn more about?
 - Ask staff: What type of technology are you comfortable with and enjoy facilitating? If given the opportunity to integrate any type of technology, what would it be? What resources and supports would you need? How will this meet our program goals and support positive youth development?
 - Ask colleagues or program partners: What type of technology have you used that your students love? Which were not popular? How did you choose? How did you get started?
 - Learn about stores/vendors that sell technology for schools and afterschool programs.
 - Sign up for newsletters.
 - Create a Pinterest board.
 - Request samples and free trials.
 - Observe a peer as he or she implements technology in activities.
 - Ask whether/how peers use technology to support homework or to foster digital citizenship.
 - Ask how peers integrate activities to build technology-related skills to support college readiness and workforce success.
 - Identify free technology that you can use without having to make many modifications.
